





When to Start

Developing a Strategy

Establishing a Timeline

- 1+ year out from moving
 - Discuss with family
 - Locate problem areas
 - Sell
- 6 months out from moving
 - Decide what to bring with you
 - Declutter: give, give, give
- 1 month out from moving
 - Line up the home sale
 - Line up the move
 - Vacant or occupied?



GETTING STARTED

- Family and Friends
- Set a timeline for deciding who gets what
- Set deadline for removal/shipping

- Room by Room Checklist:
- Inventory each room
- Painters Tape to identify
- Designate a room(s) for staging items
 - Common Mistake-Every room becomes a project




Blue=Keep Yellow=Family Red=Remove











Estate Sales






Buy-Out Basics

- You receive one lump sum for items of value
- Typically include a clean out

Clean Outs

- Gone for Good, 1-800 Got Junk
- 16-ft cube truck: pay per quarter, half, or full
- No need to pack





ALL-IN-ONE DOWNSIZING

- 1. Consult for Overall Strategy
- 2. Bring in Estate Liquidators, Buy-Out/Clean Out Companies
- 3. Establish Timeline for Move, Cleanout, Staging, and Sale



TYPICAL TIMELINES

- 8-12 months out
- Create a downsizing pathway
- Sorting
- Coordinating junk removal and/or donations
- Estimate
- Contract and deposit for move




